Meetings and Activities

- 25 technical conferences were held.
- 11 meetings (including the AGM) were held.
- A new set of bylaws was developed and passed at the AGM. A second passing at the AGM 2005 is needed to make them valid.
- A senior membership elevation programme has been started. Two senior membership elevation gatherings has been held, in Stockholm in January and in Gothenburg in November.

- During 2004 the IEEE Sweden Section Board had 5 meetings.

International activities
